Kidsafe Taranaki: In partnership with New Plymouth Injury Safe and Roadsafes Taranaki are running free child restraint clinics across Taranaki into the future. After some recent checkpoints the data has shown that only 50% of children are buckled in correctly/legally. A lot of this has to do with parents/grandparents not understanding or knowing how tight/firmly a seat should be installed or how to attach the tether strap so the seat is held in place better in the event of a crash. These clinics are non-judgmental and have been set up after feedback from parents who have never shown how to install the child restraints correctly or parents who are not sure when to move from front facing to rear facing, or when to move from booster to adult seatbelt. The Hawera clinics are on the fourth Thursday of every month and will be in the carpark of the Hawera Presbyterian Church on the corner of Argyle and High Street. Can you please share with your school/work communities and networks and encourage people to pop along and get some really valuable tips. If you require a tether bolt for your vehicle the clinics will provide you one for free and Toyota dealers across Taranaki will install them.
