

Survey results November 2018

1. What things do you like best about Turuturu School?
 - My child's teacher – 61%
 - My child likes coming to school – 57%
 - Friendly staff – 39%
 - I know how well my child is doing – 34%
 - Good communication between home & school – 34%

2. How can we make Turuturu School better?
 - Focus on wellbeing – mindfulness/mental wellness/self-management – 53%
 - Smaller class sizes – 38%
 - Reduce bullying – 28%
 - More events – discos, games evenings – 22%
 - Integrate more technology into learning – 21%

3. How can Turuturu School Better reflect Maori culture?
 - Learning Maori culture in class - 43%
 - Different cultural perspectives integrated into everyday learning – 32%
 - Karakia to start a meeting or school day – 30%
 - Increased use of Maori language by teachers & children – 28%

4. What values/qualities do you most want your child/ren to have?
 - Respect - 66%
 - Honesty – 65%
 - Self-confidence – 52%
 - Responsibility – 44%
 - Resilience – 43%

5. What's your greatest wish for your child/ren when they leave here?
 - Can manage themselves & their behaviour – 59%
 - They've enjoyed their time here – 57%
 - They're competent at reading, writing & maths – 55%
 - They have good friends – 50%

6. Is Turuturu School being an Enviro School important to you?
 - Yes – I am happy with what is happening – 66%
 - Yes – more emphasis would be good – 18%
 - No – not really – 16%

7. Is using digital devices (eg ipads, computers) to enhance children's learning important?
 - About right as it is – 70%
 - No not really, less emphasis – 19%
 - More emphasis would be good – 11%
